Saddle your horse and ride 100 miles of bridle trails in Cleveland Metroparks anytime from January 1, 2017 - December 15, 2017. Ride this self-guided tour at your own pace, on your own or with a group. **Ride is broken down into sections so you have a whole year to complete the 100 miles.**

STAY THE NIGHT WITH YOUR HORSE AND TRAILER. Registered riders may choose to stay the night in several trailheads. Special permit and rider registration number required. Form sent upon receipt of registration. ALL in your group must be registered. **Or board your horse** for the night \$35.00 at Rocky River Stables 216-267-2525 and stay at a hotel.

EMERALD NECKLACE END-TO-END RIDE - AWARD

To be eligible, riders must register and complete the challenge by riding all 7 Emerald Necklace Reservations covering (free standing) Rocky River Reservation. Mill Stream Run, Brecksville, and Bedford Reservations (which do connect). Complete the 100 miles by riding the bridle trails of the freestanding South Chagrin, North Chagrin and Hinckley Reservations. *Report your miles by December 15, 2017.*

HONORABLE MENTION AWARDS:

Riders must register and ride 100 miles or more in any one or more of the above Cleveland Metroparks reservations. *Report your miles by December 15, 2017.*

TRAIL HORSE AWARD: For the horse completing the End to End & most miles.
