Ride this self-guided tour at your own pace – on your own or with a group. **Ride is broken down into sections so you have a whole year to complete the 100 miles.**

EMERALD NECKLACE END-TO-END RIDE - AWARD

To be eligible, riders must register and complete the challenge by riding the **Emerald Necklace** end-to-end covering Rocky River Reservation, Mill Stream Run Reservation, Brecksville, Bedford and South Chagrin Reservations. You'll complete the 100 miles by riding the bridle trails of the freestanding North Chagrin and Hinckley Reservations. *Your miles must be logged and received by December 15, 2017.*

To be eligible, riders must register and ride 100 miles or more in any one of the above Cleveland Metroparks reservations. *Your miles must be logged and received by December 15, 2017.*
